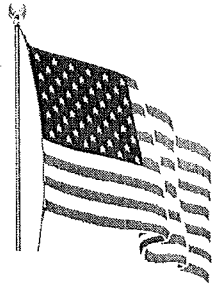


Veterans Group of San Quentin



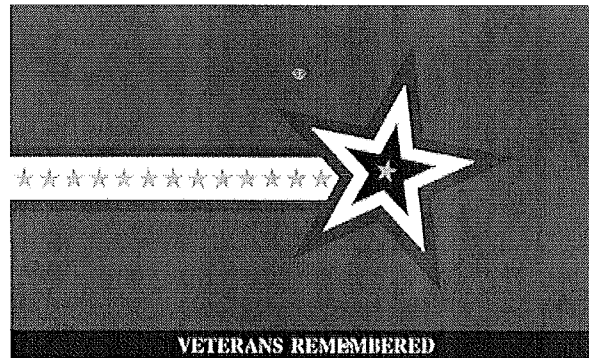
